Henry Clay, Sr. (1777 – 1852) American lawyer, politician who represented Kentucky in both the Senate and House of Rep, and was also Secretary of State from 1825-1829. Clay quotes often made their way into Lincoln's speeches saying he was "my ideal of a great man." Respected for his contributions to the country, Clay was laid in state in the Capitol rotunda, the first person ever to receive that honor. One photo bears an E. Anthony/Brady back mark.
